ACTIVITY GUIDELINE

- 10:00AM** Morning Tea
10:30AM **Activity 1:** Rabbit/Guinea Pig handling/weighing for worming

*Can swap out Activity 2 for nursery or feed trail time.

ACTIVITY 1

- Safely handle and pick up rabbits/GP's using a towel and keeping four paws in contact with floor or handler's chest/lap
- Move animal to weighing scale and weigh in bucket (make sure to zero the scale first!)
- Record weight and choose correct dosage rate for small animal wormer
- Record treatment in appropriate paperwork
- Safely move animal back to their original pen

ACTIVITY 2

- Safe handling of chickens and overall health check?

ACTIVITY 3

- Move sheep into raceway next to shearing yards, then tie Scout up on show barn stage
- Discuss drenching – why it is done and how often, how the drench gun works, how to drench safely
- Practise mock drenching (no liquid in barrel)
- Record treatment details and note down estimated weight of sheep (80kg) and dose rate
- Scout's station – practise record taking for wormer tablets/flea treatment and health check of dogs
